


VIEW OF PARK ROW AS SEEN BY ARTIST BAILEY.

today's sketch, Mr. Bailey illustrates another one of Stamford's street scenes, and likewise again our city's traffic problems which in the last few years has been great concern.

The artist has featured the well-known Strand Theatre in the dis-

tance, while adjoining this is the New Palace Theatre now under construction. This later building is being erected by the Vuono interests.

Many other important buildings and firms will be easily recognized

on the right of Mr. Bailey's drawing, including the attractive home of Hartwell and Delap Clothing Company, just indicated near the right foreground. White on the left will be noticed one or two of the stately elm trees situated in the lit-

tie park, which always adds great beauty to Stamford's civic center.

Mr. Bailey made this interesting sketch looking from the window of the G and G Shoe Repairin Parlor, which again caused great excitement among the employees seeing the artist at work.
